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






- → Need for faster information transfer




Step 1: Dramaturgy

- Rough structure
- Scene breakdown
- Video duration

SCRIPT: DRAMATURGY





Step 2: **Storyline/**Exposé

- Inserting all important
 cues & arguments
- Dramaturgy as orientation
- "Kill your darlings":

Relevant points only!



Step 3: Voice over elaboration

- Wording: simple language
- Logical continuity
- Linguistic continuity
- Variety (sentence structure, synonyms)
- High information density ("text efficiency")



Step 4: Visual elaboration

- Visual planning already in script phase
- Rhythm of actions (distance: ø 2-3 sec
- = approx. 4-6 words)
- each action/scribble = bold marked

keyword!

- symbolism
- possible with paper?



Step 5: Revision (back to Step 3)

- Language fine-tuning
- **>** Condensing:
 - Redundancy?
 - Remove exceptions & side notes
- Reduction
 - Modal verbs
 - Passive form
 - Repetition, etc.

Single scribble

- Motive
- Size
- Perspektive
- Grade of detail



Layout

- Position: above, below, same level?
- Distance: far, near, ajar?
- Action: Pull out, flip, draw together?
